

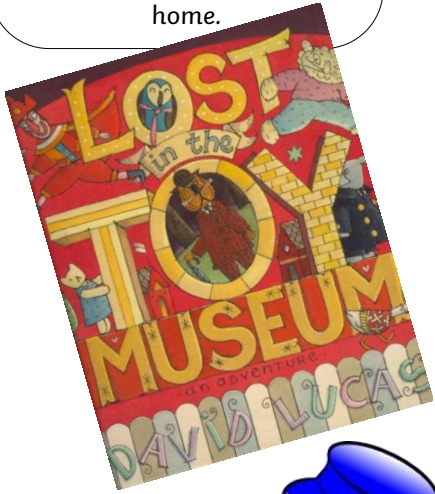
Dear Parents,

Wood

Wood is a natural material and is known as a renewable material.



Metal

Metal is a natural material and found inside rocks. This is not renewable.



Plastic

Plastic is a manmade material and can have many different finishes.

Useful words

Past- Things that have already happened.

Present- Things that are happening right now!

Future- Things that haven't happened yet or might happen.

Materials- What something is made of.

Push- a force that moves something away from you or where it is.

Pull- a force that moves something towards you or where it is.

Force- How an object can be moved such as push or pull.
