UPDATE COVID-

It is vital that we all still follow the rules and guidelines set down by the Government:

Do not send your child to school unless they have a negative lateral flow if someone in your household is positive.

Isolation period 7 days with negative lateral flow tests on 6th and 7th Day and sent to

admin@grangeview.northumberland.sch.uk, otherwise must stay at home for 10 days if still testing positive.

MASKS must be recommended to be worn by all families on school site

Masks continue to be worn by staff around all areas of school

Lunches- as normal unless cook absent then as emergency short term until other arrangements made Packed lunches must be sent in.

BREAKFAST CLUB

We are currently running this childcare facility with extremely low numbers meaning that it is not sustainable. As a gesture of goodwill siblings of Nursery children have been able to access the childcare from 8.30am free of charge but unfortunately, we cannot afford to pay staff and continue to do this.

Therefore, in January any parents wishing to drop any older sibling off at Breakfast club when they drop off for Nursery will need to pay £1 (half price) to use this childcare provision. Please pay on SIMS and book places with the office if you need to use this childcare provision.

At present we will be keeping Nursery hours 8.30-11.30am Thank you.

Class Dojo

To make communication effective and more efficient in school please can we ask parents only to use class Dojo with questions to teachers about learning and their child's class.

All queries about school lunches, attendance, lateness, illness, SIMs, medical appointments, uniform, pick-ups etc should come to Mrs Burt in the office please.

The teachers are teaching between 8.30 to 3.30 and often do not have a chance to read your messages and pass on information to the office. Thank you.

NEW CO2 monitors

The DFE have provided each class with a monitor to check each classroom is well ventilated to support keeping the children and staff safe from COVID. Although these are working well please can we remind parents that windows do stay open no matter how cold it is outside. The heating is on but please can we also encourage your child to wear layers under their uniform. Thank you

SIMS Online payments - COVID SAFE CASH FREE SYSTEM



OPERATION ENCOMPASS INFORMATION

The original initiative was aimed at supporting children who are affected by domestic abuse. The next part of the project will help all children to learn about friendships, relationships, emotions and rules so that they can live and work together safely.

<u>Operation Endeavour</u>- This is an innovative project in which schools and colleges in Northumberland are participating, and which is run in partnership with Northumberland County Council and Northumbria Police.

Operation Endeavour commenced in November 2018, aims to support children and young people who go missing from home. Children who go missing from home are at risk of significant harm and they may be vulnerable to sexual exploitation, violent crime, gang exploitation, or to drug and alcohol misuse.

As a result, following any report of a child going missing to the Police, the Police will make contact with Children's Social Care who will then communicate relevant and necessary information to nominated school staff.

Each school has members of staff (key adults) who have been fully trained in liaising with the Police and Children's Social Care when required, and will ensure that the necessary support is made available to the child or young person following their return.

I believe that this project demonstrates our school's commitment to working in partnership to safeguard and protect children, and to providing the best possible care and support for our pupils.
