This half term '**The Little Red Hen**' will be available at the library or in school for you to borrow and share at home.

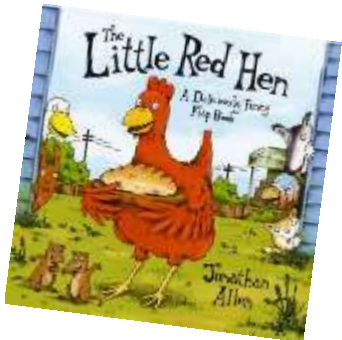

**Castle**– A large building, typically of the medieval period, fortified against attack with thick walls, battlements, towers, and in many cases a moat.

**Moat** – A deep, wide ditch surrounding a castle typically filled with water.

**Author** – a writer of a book, article, or document.

**Illustrator** - a person who draws or creates pictures for magazines, books, advertising, etc.
