New Payment System

We are currently in the process of switching payment systems from Pay360 to Schoolmoney. The new system will go live as soon as we come back in September. **Please make sure that NO payments are made in Pay360 after 21st July 2023 as the system will no longer exist.** All parents will be sent an invitation to download the new Schoolmoney app in the summer holidays. All breakfast club and after school club places need to be booked in and paid for in advance on Schoolmoney.

School Lunches

As you know the cost of living for all of us is having an impact on everyone's wellbeing. As a school, lunch costs of £2.20 have remained the same for several years. Unfortunately, our food costs have also increased and we are unable to subsidise this any further. Therefore, from September we have been encouraged to increase the costs to £2.70. I have met with the governors who have agreed to set our cost at £2.50 for the Autumn Term and then review this at Christmas. Apologies for this but we have held them as low as possible for as long as we could. Thank you for your support.

Summer term attendance expectations for schools and Changes in September

School attendance continues to be mandatory for all pupils and the usual rules on school attendance apply. This includes parents' duty to ensure their child regularly attends school, and schools' and local authorities' ability to issue sanctions, including fixed penalty notices, for poor attendance.

The school and local authority is expected to continue to communicate clear expectations around attendance to families, identify pupils at risk of disengagement and develop plans to re-engage them.

As restrictions begin to lift, we know some families may be looking to take holidays during term time. As usual, parents should plan their holidays around school breaks and avoid seeking permission to take their children out of school on holiday please. **Look out for new expectations for September 2023!**

*****NEW Wraparound Childcare*****

From September we will be trialling Wraparound Childcare again for all our families.

Breakfast clubs will start earlier at 7:30am-8:50am for £2 or £1 from 8:00-8:50am every morning, and after school will run 3.15-5.15pm for £4 per hour including a snack/drink. These will be run by Miss Gray and Miss Bell. Breakfast club in the hall as normal and after school care in the Early Years unit to allow access to the outdoor area. Please inform the office if you wish to reserve spaces or find out more.

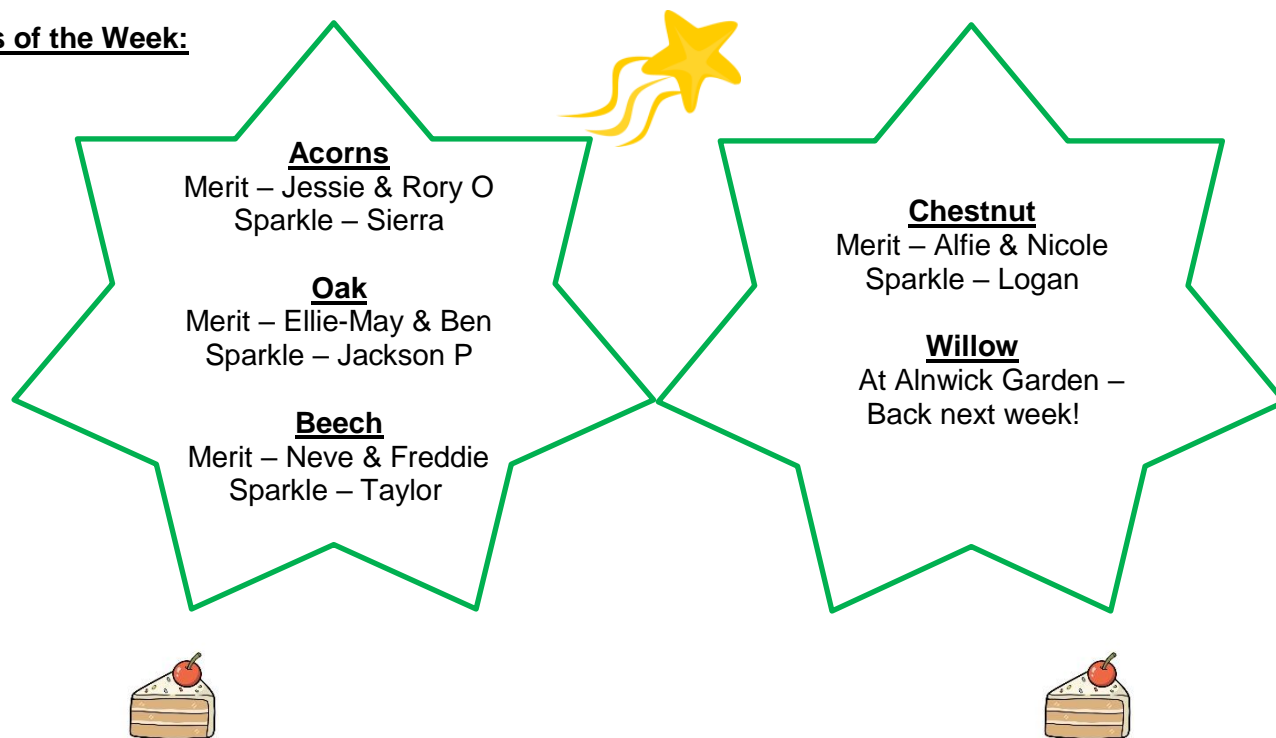

OPERATION ENCOMPASS INFORMATION

The original initiative was aimed at supporting children who are affected by domestic abuse. The next part of the project will help all children to learn about friendships, relationships, emotions and rules so that they can live and work together safely.

Operation Endeavour - This is an innovative project in which schools and colleges in Northumberland are participating, and which is run in partnership with Northumberland County Council and Northumbria Police.

Operation Endeavour commenced in November 2018, aims to support children and young people who go missing from home. Children who go missing from home are at risk of significant harm and they may be vulnerable to sexual exploitation, violent crime, gang exploitation, or to drug and alcohol misuse.

As a result, following any report of a child going missing to the Police, the Police will make contact with Children's Social Care who will then communicate relevant and necessary information to nominated school staff.

Each school has members of staff (key adults) who have been fully trained in liaising with the Police and Children's Social Care when required, and will ensure that the necessary support is made available to the child or young person following their return.

I believe that this project demonstrates our school's commitment to working in partnership to safeguard and protect children, and to providing the best possible care and support for our pupils.
