### **Useful words**

**Danger** – the possibility of something happening that will injure, harm or kill somebody, or damage or destroy something.

**Emergency** - an urgent, unexpected, and usually dangerous situation that poses a risk to health, life, property, or environment and requires immediate action.

**Doctor** – a person who has been trained in medical science, whose job is to treat people who are ill or injured.

**Paramedic** – a trained medic who comes to medical emergencies after 999 has been called. They give treatment and transfer patients to hospital if needed.

**Ambulance** – a special vehicles used to help people who are sick or hurt get to the hospital quickly.

**Dentist** - is a person who is trained to look after people's teeth and give advice of how to look after them.

**Fiction** – stories that are made from our imaginations.

**Non-fiction** – information texts that are fact-based.

**Easter** – is the holiest time of the year for Christians and celebrates Jesus coming back to life (resurrection).

**Christians** – people who belong to the religion based on the teachings of Jesus Christ.
