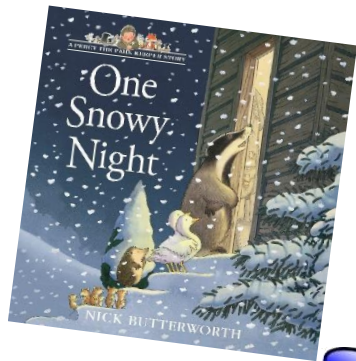


Dear Parents,

Things to remember:

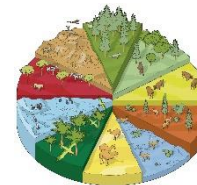
Monday-

Useful words

Chinese New Year – annual 15-day festival in China and Chinese communities around the world that begins with the new moon.

Arctic - regions around the North Pole.

Antarctic - the south polar region.

Church - a building used for public Christian worship.

Christian - people who follow or adhere to Christianity, a religion based on the life and teachings of Jesus Christ.

Hail – frozen rain.

Frost - small white ice crystals when the temperature falls below freezing.
