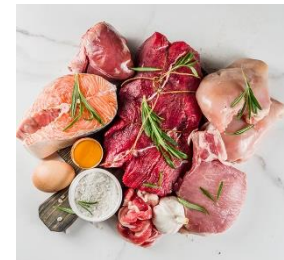
herbivore
