Useful words

Seed – small parts produced by plants from which new plants grow

Roots -Roots absorb minerals and water from the soil.

Stem -The stem transports water around the plant. It also holds the plant upright so it can get more sunlight.

Leaves - Leaves make food for the plant from carbon dioxide in the air and sunlight.

petals - Petals attract insects to the plant.

Pollination – the transfer of pollen to produce more seeds
