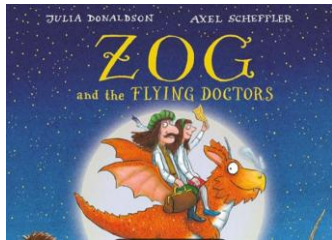


Dear Parents,

Help – doing something kind for someone who needs it. You make things easier for them.

Police- police are grown-ups who help keep people safe. They make sure everyone follows the rules.

Fire service- the fire service is a group of helpers who put out fires and keep people safe.

RNLI- the RNLI is a group of helpers who go out in boats to save people in the sea. They help anyone who is in trouble in the water.

Dentist- a dentist is a helper who looks after your teeth. They make sure your teeth are clean, healthy, and strong.

Healthy- healthy means your body feels good and strong. You eat good food, play, and rest so you can grow.

Emergency- an emergency is when something happens and you need help quickly.

Safety- safety means keeping your body safe so you don't get hurt. It's when you follow rules that help you stay okay.
