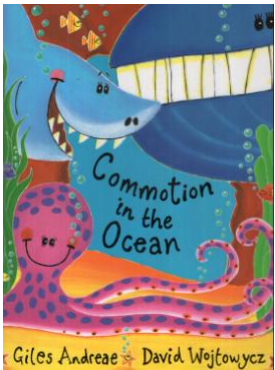


Dear Parents,

Grow

Grow means to get bigger, stronger, or smarter over time, just like plants, animals, and people do.

Change

Change means when something becomes different from how it was before, and that can feel surprising, new, or even exciting.

Fear

Fear is a feeling you get when something seems scary or makes you worry, even if you're actually safe.

Useful words

Sea creature – an animal that lives in the sea/ocean.

Beach- a beach is a place where land meets the sea. You might find sand there.

Pirate- a pirate is a person who sails on a ship, they might be looking for treasure and adventure.

Aquarium – a place you can see and learn about animals that live in the sea/in water.

Map– is like a drawing that shows where places and things are.

Float – when something stays on top of the water instead of going under.

Sink- when something goes under the water or to the bottom of the water.
